- Membership Policies and Procedures Updates
 - Policies and Procedures update to include a length of time from last OCS involvement to be eligible for Panel membership as well as a reporting requirement for current members if they become involved with OCS during their membership.
 - Possibility of changing OCS involvement language in CRP Membership Application to distinguish between a parent involved with OCS and a previous OCS employee.
- Review OCS Response to CRP Annual Report
 - OCS agreed with the Panels approach to how the Annual Report was conducted and the findings that came from it. No real points of contention.

- Possibility of changing the wording of the CRP funding at the legislative level as it is currently written as “contractors” on the line item which may lead to some confusion.
- Round Table Discussion: Final Questionnaire and Schedule Coordination
 - Schedule and OCS worker coordination need to be decided on prior to next steps being solidified for Round Tables.
 - There are 232 front line workers in OCS at the current time with 25% vacancies statewide.
 - Panel to prioritize workers in the regions that they live and work in with approximately 15 workers per meeting and about 2 hours in length.
 - Panel would like to get perspective from traveling workers in rural offices as well.
 - Round Table Scheduling with OCS and Panel Members.
